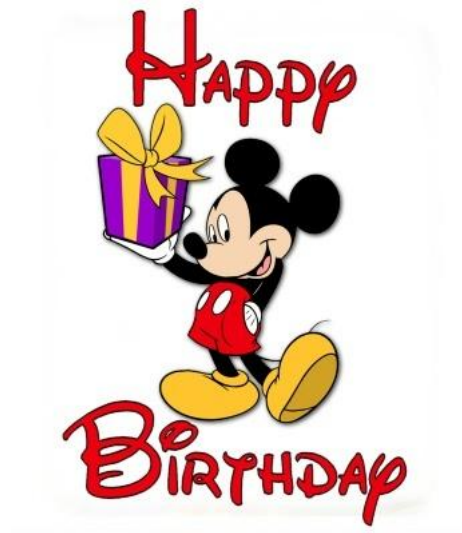


A Prayer for Courage
